A Chance to Visit Air Salvage International

Mark Gregory **Founder and CEO**

Formed in 1997 ASI is a global industry leader and was the first aircraft disassembly company to be established in Europe.

The usual format is a 40-minute talk by Mark Gregory about the history of the company and the aircraft disassembly market sector in general. This is followed by a walk to Hangar H2 and the apron outside to view aircraft undergoing the disassembly process, before boarding a vintage Boeing 727.

The final stage is a short mini-bus ride to the Belfast site to view aircraft in the final stages of disassembly.
