

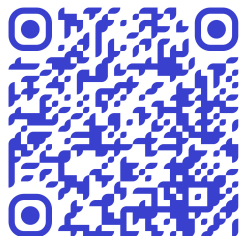

Lancashire and Cumbria Local Network **Wind Tunnel Capability in Lancashire(Preston)**

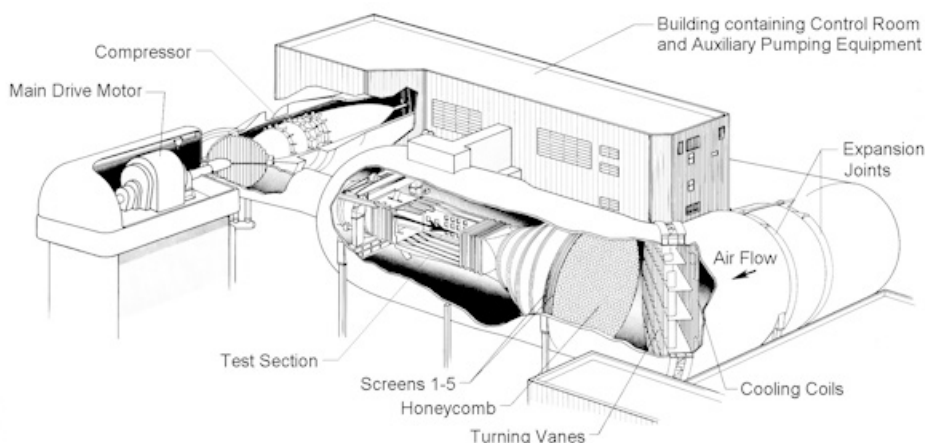
Join experienced wind-tunnel engineer Craig Eckersley for an inside look at Lancashire's aerodynamic testing facilities.
