Hydrogen in transport – is it the future?

Dr Penny Atkins School of Architecture, Technology and Engineering

The UK Government Hydrogen Strategy puts hydrogen at the heart of meeting net zero in transport, targeting sectors like heavy duty transport that are difficult to electrify.

This talk will consider the broader implications of the use of hydrogen in these sectors and review recent research from University of Brighton, Advanced Engineering Centre on the use of hydrogen fuelled combustion engines in heavy duty vehicles and small marine vessels.
